Quick Start Guide

How long can I check out books & items?

Items **automatically renew** if they are not on hold for another patron. Some special items cannot be renewed. (See chart.)

Item Type	Loan Period (Days)	Fine Per day (¢)	Renewals	Item Limit
Books	14	5¢	10	100
Express Books	14	5¢	0	100
DVDs & Blu-rays	7	50¢	10	20
Movie Express DVDs & Blu-rays	3	50¢	0	20
Magazines	7	5¢	1	50
CDs & Books on CD	14	5¢	10	50
Library of Things	7	50¢	0	1 of each item type
Museum Passes	7	\$1.00	0	1 pass

Items from other libraries ordered through SearchOHIO and OhioLINK may be subject to different loan periods, fines, and fees.

How can I track my checkouts & holds?

View your account, current checkouts, items on hold, pay fines, or request materials 24/7 through the online catalog or mobile app (available on Google Play & The App Store). Visit www.fallslibrary.org to log in with your card number and PIN (usually the last four digits of your phone number.)

How will I know when my holds are ready for pick-up? How long are they held?

You have **7 days** to pick up your items. We will call, email and/or text based on the preferences you set during sign-up. You can change these anytime in your online account or contact us!

Where do I pick up my holds?

Stop in and pick up your holds on the shelves to the right of our self-checkout stations. Or, visit our **drive-thru**, and we'll grab them for you!

Can I use my Cuyahoga Falls Library card at other libraries in Summit County?

No, Cuyahoga Falls Library is not part of any other library system. (**Please do not return items borrowed from our library to any other location!**) However, you *can* use your Falls Library card to order and borrow thousands of materials from libraries across the state! Visit our website, search for an item, then click the **SearchOhio** or **OhioLink** button.
